

## Acadia National Park Vegetation Map Class for Aspen – Birch Woodland/Forest Complex (woodland phase)

The map class "[Aspen – Birch Woodland/Forest Complex \(woodland phase\)](#)" is composed of the following vegetation associations, each described separately:

- [Early Successional Woodland/Forest](#)
- [Birch - Oak Talus Woodland](#)

ABW has a woodland appearance with an open canopy. Tree height is generally less than ABF. ABW is similar in composition to ABF, dominated by aspen species (either trembling or bigtooth) and to some extent, red maple. Birches are often present.
