

Acadia National Park Vegetation Map Class for Open Water - Deep Marsh Complex

The map class "Open Water - Deep Marsh Complex" is composed of the following vegetation associations, each described separately:

- Seven-angle Pipewort - Dortmann's Cardinal-flower Herbaceous Vegetation
- Eastern Cattail Marsh
- Bulrush Deepwater Marsh
- Open Water Marsh with Mixed Submergents/Emergents
- Water Lily Aquatic Wetland

The Open Water - Deep Marsh Complex map class (OWM) is a broad map class encompassing shallow emergent marsh vegetation such as sedges, cattails, grasses, and deep marsh floating and submersed vegetation such as water lilies and pondweeds.
