

Saltgrass Herbaceous Vegetation (Map Code 40)



Location: *Distichlis spicata* Herbaceous Vegetation occupies flats on floodplain terraces within the Green River floodplain. This vegetation type is readily invaded by salt-cedar, and the most open stands observed were in Brennan Flats, Leota Bottom, and Sheppard Bottom.

Signature: This type exhibited a very pale green to light blue signature resulting from little green vegetation. Texture for this type was generally coarse due to the presence of salt cedar and other shrubs. This type was partly delineated based on its topographic position in the floodplain.
